1 In accordance with the document on *Organization and method of work of the Maritime Safety Committee and the Marine Environment Protection Committee and their subsidiary bodies* (MSC-MEPC.1/Circ.5/Rev.7):

- .1 documents should be received by the Secretariat by **Friday, 28 August 2026** (four-week deadline);
- .2 documents commenting on those referred to in sub-paragraph .1 above, should be received by **Friday, 11 September 2026** (two-week deadline);
- .3 for reasons of economy, documents should be submitted in single spacing, and be as concise as possible, and:

- .1 all documents should include a brief summary prepared in accordance with section 6 of the annex to MSC-MEPC.1/Circ.5/Rev.7;
- .2 substantive documents should conclude with a summary of the action which the Experts Group is invited to take; and
- .3 information documents should conclude with a summary of the information contained therein; and
- .4 the following word-processing format should be observed in order to standardize the presentation of documents:
  - font: Arial;
  - font size: 11 pt;
  - justification: full;
  - margins: 2 cm top, 2.5 cm bottom, left and right.

To facilitate processing, documents should be submitted (in DOCX format) via the Meeting Document Submission Portal, available on the IMODOCS home page (<https://docs.imo.org>) under the "Submissions" tab, as set out in paragraph 6.2 of MSC-MEPC.1/Circ.5/Rev.7 (see Circular Letter [4662](#) for detailed information on how to use the Submission Portal).
